Monday November 10, 2014

The Portland City Council met in regular session on Monday November 10, 2014 in the Memorial Hall Building. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Mickels. Also present were Aldermen Heather Amb, JoAnna Nielson, Josh Braaten, and Public Works Director Ben Basol. Absent was Alderman Ed Lenaburg. Also present were Attorney Lynn Slaathaug Moen and Deputy Sheriff Conrad Steinhaus.

City discussed current request from Traill Rural Waster district for monies for incorrect billings in 2009. Motion Amb, second Nielson to sign a new contract with Traill Rural Water and to offer a 50% payment for the incorrect billings done by Traill Rural Water in 2009, on roll, all aye, motion carried.

Deputy Steinhaus presented the proposed multi city Animal Control Ordinances that would be consistent ordinances for the cities of Portland, Mayville and Hatton for the Traill County Sheriff's to enforce. Buildings/Grounds/Equipment – JoAnna Nielson: no report. **Director of Public Works**: Informed the council that the NDDOT has requested the removal of the Welcome to Portland signs. Grader sealed bids were presented. Motion Nielson, second Braaten to accept high bid for

the Galion grader, all aye, motion carried. Motion Braaten, second Nielson to accept high bid for the Cat #12 motor grader, all aye, motion carried.

Resident in attendance inquired as to getting some of the re mils left from the street improvement project. Resident informed to take what he needs. Resident also complimented Public Works Director Ben Basol on his performance.

Motion Braaten, second Amb to give a \$1000.00 donation to the Portland Rural Fire Department, on roll, all aye, motion carried.
