The Auditor's office approved a permit for a raffle for the Spanish Travelers for MPCG and a raffle permit for the Fireman's fund raiser on March 19th, 2016.

O'Brien made a motion to accept the first reading of:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER XVI, ARTICLE 11 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF 1979 OF THE CITY OF MAYVILLE RELATING TO REGULATIONS FOR MOTORCYCLES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYVILLE, NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 16-1108 is hereby added to the Revised Ordinances of 1979 of the City of Mayville to provide as follows:

16-1108A DEFINITIONS.

For the purpose of this Chapter, the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

- (1) ALL TERRAIN VEHICLE (ATV). ATVs are motorized flotation-tired vehicles with at least three but no more than six low pressure tires that have an engine displacement of less than 1,000 cubic centimeters and total dry weight of up to 1,800 pounds total dry weight. Dry weight is normally the weight of the vehicle without fluids.
- (2) MOTORIZED GOLF CART. A vehicle, usually three or four wheeled, which is self-propelled and designed to normally provide transportation on a golf course.

16-1108B RULES OF OPERATION.

ATVs or Motorized golf carts may be operated on city streets in the City of Mayville only under the following conditions and subject to the following restrictions:

- (1) ATVs or golf carts may be operated only by persons with valid driver's licenses.
- (2) ATVs or golf cart operators must have proper proof of liability insurance for the operated vehicle in accordance with the requirements of N.D.C.C. 39-16.1-11.
- (3) ATV or golf carts may not be operated on walking/bike paths or sidewalks.
- (4) ATVs or golf carts may be operated on city streets only between sunrise and sunset.
- (5) No person shall operate an ATV or motorized golf cart in inclement weather or when visibility is impaired.
- (6) ATVs or golf carts may only carry the number of passengers for which the vehicle is designed.
- (7) ATV or golf cart operators must obey and are subject to all state and local traffic laws that motor vehicles are subject to.
- (8) Golf carts may not be operated on federal, state or county highways, except for the perpendicular crossing of these highways.

16-1108C LIMITATION OF LIABILITY.

January 4th, 2016

(1) Nothing in this chapter shall be construed as an assumption of liability by the city for any injuries to persons or property which may result from the operation of a motorized golf cart or ATV.

16-1108D PENALTY.

Except as otherwise provided in this article, anyone violating the provisions of this article shall be punished by a fine of up to five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per incident.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its final passage and publication.
