## July 1st, 2019 Mayville City Council

The Mayville City Council met in regular session on July 1st, 2019 at 6:00 pm in the council chambers with Mayor Bensen presiding and the following Aldermen responding to call of the roll: Carr, Bohnsack, O'Brien, Meshefski-Labine, Petersen. Absent: None. Also, in attendance: Gail Olstad, Julie Christianson, Shelia Anderson, Cassie Tostenson.

O'Brien made a motion to accept the approval agenda on the following items:

- 1. Minutes from 6-3-19 meeting.
- 2. Auditor's office approvals: Heroes & Legends transfer liquor license for street dance during Summerfest, June 22 until 2:00 am June 23, 2019
- 3. Upcoming Conference: ND League of Cities Annual Conference, September 19-21, Bismarck Event Center (three motel rooms have been reserved.)
- 4. Audit: Audit fieldwork is complete. Draft report and Council presentation within a couple of months.
- 5. Special Election July 9: Two candidates for vacant position. Notices have been posted. Securing workers.
- 6. ND League of Cities Legislative Review: Mayor Bensen attended the session in Carrington June 4. HB1066 Municipal Infrastructure Fund – Capital construction to construct new or replace existing infrastructure including sewer and water lines, storm water infrastructure including curb and gutter and other projects. No debt repayment. HB1356 Bidding on Construction on Public Improvements – Increases bidding and engineering threshold from \$150000.00 to \$200000.00; HB1435 State Interoperable Radio Network (SIRN) – provides state cost sharing for each radio up to \$1500.00.
- 7. Planning and Zoning Committee: Perry Paschke has agreed to serve on the committee.
- 8. Blight discussion including write-ups, notices, extra-territorial requirements.
- 9. Bank of North Dakota Infrastructure Revolving Loan Fund Program. Bank of North Dakota is now accepting applications for this fund program. It would be used for water or wastewater treatment plants, sewer, storm sewer and water lines, transportation infrastructure (including curb & gutter construction). These funds may be used for new construction, repair & replacement.
- NDDOT Special Road Fund Project Applications: The NDDOT is accepting applications for Special Road Fund (SRF) projects. SRF projects are limited to roads that provide access to and/or are within recreational, tourist and historical areas.
