

September 6th, 2019 Mayville City Council

The Mayville City Council met in Public Hearing for Building Variance Request on September 6, 2019 at 5:45 pm in the council chambers with Mayor Bensen presiding and the following Aldermen responding to call of the roll: Moen, Petersen. Absent: Meshefski-LaBine, O'Brien, Carr and Bohnsack. Also, in attendance: Gail Olstad, Julie Christianson and Mike Bradner. The Planning & Zoning committee members present Brent Freeland, Jim Lande, Gary Winger, Perry Paschke, Jon Ewen.

The meeting was called to order.

Jon Ewen made the motion to approve a building variance for the new Greenhouse on the south side of MayPort CG Middle & High School. Perry Paschke seconded the motion, motion was carried. The Greenhouse will be 24' x 48' with a 32 ft setback. The zoning ordinance states that the setback is 60 ft off the property line but due to placement and size it will need to be 32', this aligns with the Radio Station and is consistent with the zoning prior to the annexation into City Limits. Bradner assured that the Greenhouse would be in line with all other structures along Highway 200.

A motion was made by Gary Winger to adjourn this meeting, with Perry Paschke seconding the motion, motion was carried.
