Department Head Reports: Police – Ed Lenaburg: Sheriff Hunt joined the meeting. Sheriff Hunt reviewed changes affecting the City of Portland and discussed community visibility of officers. Motion Lenaburg, second Hutchins to purchase of new patrol car with cost split between Hatton and the City of Portland, on roll, all aye, motion carried. Motion Basol, second Hutchins to approve county hazard mitigation plan, all aye, motion carried. Streets – Jerod Basol: no report. Water – Heather Hutchins: Overdue bills discussed. Nine (9) accounts scheduled to be turned off on Monday January 29, 2018 for non-payment. Letter to be sent to overdue accounts stating that the balance of these accounts must be paid in full to prevent water from being shut off. A \$100 turn on fee must be paid before water service will be restored. Failure to pay the fee and turn water on without the city approval will result in theft of services charges being filed by the City of Portland through the Traill County Sheriff's office. All accounts for Traill County Housing to be mailed to Traill County Housing in Hillsboro with a copy of the bills sent to the Fargo office, and not to individual customers. Buildings/Grounds/Equipment – JoAnna Nielson: Purchase of new street banners discussed. Additional information to be presented at the February meeting. Director of Public Works - Ben Basol: no report.
