All the residents living along the alley (6th Ave NE in Mayville) had agreed at first to have their alley paved and they would all split the cost among themselves. Larry Young who live along there is stating that his neighbors have all backed out on him. He said he will pay for just his side of the alley meaning just half of the alley all along there will be paved. So, this will be a change order for Zavoral in which they have been made known.

The City would like to have cameras set up at the landfill as we have had issues of people driving around the gate and dumping illegally. The Auditor has talked with Network Center on the cost of getting cameras out there. We would need to get electricity out there. Liv from Network Center first contacted Xcel Energy about this and was quoted \$90,000 to put electricity out at the landfill. Liv then contacted Nodak Electric and was quoted \$16,000 from them to put electricity out at the landfill. Then Xcel Energy came back with a quote of \$5,000 to put electricity out there. Moen made the motion to accept the quote of \$5,000 for electricity to be put out at the landfill. Petersen seconded the motion and upon a roll call vote the following voted; Yea: Gates, Moen, Petersen; Nay: Zero; Absent: Soholt, O'Brien, Bohnsack.

There are 2 manholes on Hwy 200 that need fixing. One is on Hwy 18 between Subway and homes along there. The other manhole is on the west side of the railroad tracks between the Traill County Tribune office and Subway. Cal Peterson has talked with Naastad Bros about fixing those two manholes.

Petersen made the motion to adjourn the meeting, Moen seconded the motion, motion was carried.
